SECTION 1 - WHAT DO WE DO WITH YOUR INFORMATION?

When you support The Right Course, make an enquiry or donation, we collect the personal information you give us such as your name, organisation name, address and email address.

SECTION 2 - CONSENT

How do you get my consent?

When you provide us with personal information to complete a transaction, attend an event, we imply that you consent to our collecting it and using it for that specific reason only.

If we ask for your personal information for a secondary reason, like marketing, we will provide you with an opportunity to say no.

How do I withdraw my consent?

SECTION 4 - THIRD-PARTY SERVICES

In general, the third-party providers used by us will only collect, use and disclose your information to the extent necessary to allow them to perform the services they provide to us.

However, certain third-party service providers, such as payment gateways and other payment transaction processors, have their own privacy policies in respect to the information we are required to provide to them for your purchase-related transactions.
